Designations Policy



Introduction

AILA exists for its members. As a member-based organisation it seeks to promote the value of the organisation, including the ability for members to demonstrate their membership as a source of pride and to enhance their professional standing.

1. Purpose

This policy sets out the basis on which designation may be used by AILA Members.

2. Compliance

This policy applies to full members of the institute that are in good standing.

Please refer to the *Membership Benefits Guidelines* for member category and designations inclusions within the categories.

3. Policy

Using an AILA designation is a symbol of membership recognition and standing. It is intended to be recognised amongst clients, employers, and peers within AILA and the profession as well as amongst the government and general public to demonstrate that the member is committed to the highest level of professionalism as a Landscape Architect.

Designations for Registered Landscape Architects are certified as the result of formally assessed processes put in place for the registration and mentorship of full AILA members. This certification is based on qualifications, experience and professional standards to attest a benchmark of quality and knowledge recognised by prospective employers, clients, governments, and local and international members of the profession.

Fellowship recognition is a process of nominations made by peers within the industry to award an individual for the outstanding work within AILA and the profession.
