### **REGIONAL ACHIEVEMENT IN LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE**

---

In 2018, the Queensland Executive has approved a new award that will be presented as part of the 2018 Queensland Landscape Architecture Awards.

This is a cross category award that recognises achievement in landscape architecture in Queensland's key regions. The Regional Achievement in Landscape Architecture may be awarded in the regions of Gold Coast, Sunshine Coast, Darling Downs, Central Queensland and North Queensland. This award will be judged against the core criteria framework of the AILA Qld Landscape Architecture Awards (as outlined in the Entry Guide) and the significant difference they make to improving the healthy communities and built and natural environments of the region.

Awards will be considered by the jury based on entries captured as part of the AILA Qld Landscape Architecture Awards program – there is no separate entry process or fee. The project does not need to win the entry category to be eligible for this award. The Regional Landscape Architecture Award is a Chapter Award and not a national category and therefore the winner of this Award will not move forward to the AILA National Awards. The Jury may choose to give no award in a region.

### **AWARDS ENTRY SHOWCASE**

In 2018, AILA Queensland will be hosting an Awards Entry Showcase event. This new event will announce the entries for all categories at a member networking event.

Entries will be announced at the event using the information supplied in your entry form (including project name and hero images). No additional artwork is required.
