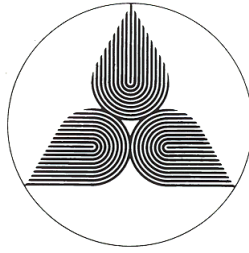

NOMINATION INFORMATION

GENERAL

The membership grade of Fellowship is an honour that the Institute may bestow upon registered members of the Institute and is made in recognition of distinguished service to the Institute and/or the profession in Australia.

The requirements are: Distinguished service to the Institute and/ or to the profession of landscape architecture in Australia at either/or both a national and state level.

DISTINGUISHED SERVICE TO THE INSTITUTE

There should be a clear demonstration of support for AILA, its goals and objectives and participation in raising the profile and standing of the Institute in the community generally, among other professions, industry, government and to students and other potential AILA members.

National Level

- Distinguished service on AILA Council where the nominees' contribution is demonstrably greater than merely 'occupying a seat' for one or two terms. This greater contribution may be evidenced by:
 - Executive Position(s)
 - Significant policy, financial and/or administrative initiatives
 - Successful implementation of particular projects, task forces, committees, etc.
 - Role in National/State coordination and conferences.
 - Direct service, advocacy and support to members and/or particular groups of members.
- Representation of AILA in forums outside Council.
- International liaison with other landscape architectural bodies.

State Level

- Distinguished service to a State Group, where the nominee's contribution is demonstrably greater than merely occupying an Executive position or Sub-committee role for one or two terms. This greater contribution may be evidenced by:
 - Pivotal role in establishing, building up and/or maintaining the Group
 - Significant policy and/or administrative initiatives
 - Successful implementation of particular projects, task forces, committees, etc.
 - Role in National/State coordination and support
 - Conferences, seminars and Continuing Professional Development
 - Consistency of service over many years.
- Representation of AILA in forums outside the State Group.

DISTINGUISHED SERVICE TO LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE

This covers a wide range of activities but is generally covered by the following:

- A clear demonstration of support for the profession of landscape architecture
- Participation in raising the profile and standing of the profession in the community generally, among other professions, industry and government.
- Receipt of awards, both from the Institute and outside organisations.
- Participation in nationally-significant projects which raise the profile and standing of the profession.
- Establishment, improvement and long-term maintenance of educational standards.
- Pioneering new areas for the profession.
- Providing a mentor and role-model role for young graduates.
- Achieving consistently high standards of work.
- High profile within the community.
- Participation in research, publications, conferences and seminars.
- Establishing and maintaining links with other professions, industry, educational institutions and government.

NOMINATION PROCEDURE

The procedure for nomination is:

- Nomination for Fellow, together with the Citation, is to be completed by two registered members acting as Proposer and Secunder. The 'Citation' form summarises the Nominee's distinguished service and will be used for promotions and the certificate.
- The nomination and citation are forwarded through the Executive Director.
- The Executive Director prepares a confidential report in consultation with appropriate members to verify the information and include additional information which may assist Council in its evaluation.
- Council evaluates the nomination. If approved, the Nominee is invited to accept Fellowship.
- On acceptance, the membership is advised through publication in the Institute Journal.

Example ONE

The AILA National Council has awarded a Fellowship to XXXXXX for his significant commitment to the profession of landscape architecture and to his enormous contributions and passion for improving the environment

The AILA National Council has awarded a Fellowship to xxxxxx for her significant commitment to the profession of landscape architecture and the Institute, xxxxx being a dedicated AILA member for 18 years.

xxxx is well known for her on-going commitments to the profession and the wider community, this being demonstrated through her membership of such bodies such as the VVVV Council and her continuous contributions to many publications and forums, including Landscape Australia and Australia ICOMOS.

xxxx has contributed nationally to debates, conferences and forums particularly on the subject of education and the future of the profession. Within vvvv a, she has a solid reputation for working to establish and maintain links between the profession, the students and recent graduates. The AILA vvv Group has benefited over the years from her generous contributions and high standard of professionalism.

Example THREE

xxxxx has been nominated as a Fellow in recognition of his contributions to the AILA and the profession through participation on the State Executive and in the last two years as State President. The Fellowship recognises his valued and on-going contributions to education and mentoring and to his initiatives in cooperative activities with other state groups.

The Fellowship acknowledges xxxx's high achievements in practice which have resulted in awards and the raising of the profile of the profession within the wider community.

The Fellowship also acknowledges XXXX's high achievements as a Landscape Architect in State Government Service with responsibilities concerned with BBBB's planning system, spatial and content management systems and custodianship of the statewide planning scheme mapping for BBBB.
