The redevelopment of the parklands will incorporate world-class design in its high quality spaces and create a more natural landscape for family activities, cultural events and active recreation by its incorporation of environmentally sustainable design, ensuring energy efficiency and water sustainability. It provides a link to re-connect the Southport CBD with Broadwater whilst aiming to generate a strong sense of community, regional identity and celebrate the history of Southport. Above all, the new parklands will provide a community facility that celebrates 150 years of Queensland as a separate state from New South Wales.

Shaun Walsh is the Design Manager for PLACE Brisbane. There are many case studies where water sensitive urban design is meaningfully integrated into parklands and can increase park amenity, however typically no open space credits are available for WSUD approaches. Is it time for a fresh approach? PLACE Design Group and Bligh Tanner have been engaged by the SEQ Healthy waterways Partnership's Water by Design program to prepare a discussion paper exploring issues and approaches to integrating water sensitive urban design and public open space, and Shaun will present some of the key findings from this work.
