Recreation Leisure Play

A significant increase in population growth and density is forecast for Queensland's South-East in the next 20 years. This raises the question of how we plan and accommodate the increase in recreation needs for its inhabitants in the future. The topic Recreation Leisure Play was chosen to inform participants about developments in Brisbane and to stimulate discussions about future recreation needs and opportunities in a growing city. Presentations include Brisbane's latest park development by the State Government and two creative initiatives by the Brisbane City Council.

Kangaroo Point Park by Julian Jakobs

The park was officially opened by Queensland Premier Anna Bligh on Sunday 24 January 2010 and developed by the Department of Public Works in collaboration with key stakeholders. The Kangaroo Point TAFE formerly occupied the park grounds. Julian Jakobs is a Senior Landscape Architect with Project Services, a business unit of the Department of Public Works.

subARTS Strategy by Paul Songhurst

Paul will present an overview of the subARTS Strategy – suburban substations as gritty places for artists and designers, illustrating how a simple, yet exciting idea can powerfully contribute to the recreation, leisure and play opportunity for Australia's new world city. Paul Songhurst is a registered Landscape Architect, currently engaged as a Public Space Planner with Brisbane City Council's Community Facilities, Sport and Recreation section.

'Inhabit' program by Tanya Neville

The Inhabit program is designed to activate small, undiscovered places in the CBD through the programming of arts and events. At its core 'Inhabit' was designed to offer a creative drawcard, attracting CBD regulars and visitors alike to engage and interact with otherwise overlooked spaces, adding a new experience to the city centre. Tanya Neville is as a Project Director with Brisbane City Council's City Planning and Sustainability Division working on the City Centre Master Plan.
