Morning - SpaceShaper Technology

Session 1: Creating Active Communities: How can open and public spaces in urban and suburban environments support active living? A Literature Review

Associate Professor Dr Jon Kellett- School of Natural and Built Environments, University of South Australia

In 2009 the SA Active Living Coalition identified a need for more evidence/guidance about the role and importance of open and public space in supporting active living. In line with the directions contained in the 30 -Year Plan for Adelaide the Review includes a specific focus on higher densities and transit-oriented developments. The literature review was commissioned from the Institute for Sustainable Systems and Technologies, the University of South Australia. The report identifies the academic and policy evidence around: amount, types of public open space, uses of public open space, location of spaces and design of space.

Michael Westley is a Chartered Landscape Architect with 20 years of experience in landscape, urban & inclusive design and in teaching, research & publication. His portfolio includes work in the private, public & voluntary sectors including appointments as an establishing Principal for a Groundwork Trust (South West), Program Manager for the Sensory Trust, an Inclusive Design Charity, and as a CABE Space Enabler & Advisor. Michael is also part of the SpaceShaper Team based in the UK. SpaceShaper is a technology that is used to measure the quality of a public space. 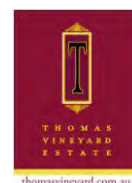
During Michael's talk he will be discussing:

- In a nutshell portrait of the Spaceshaper tools,
- Introduction to the issue of assessing quality, rather than just quantity of provision and of innate value, in the consideration of public open space
- A consideration of why the assessment of quality (amongst a diverse community of the open spaces stakeholders) might be beneficial in future design and strategic management terms
- The background of the Spaceshaper tool's evolution & the issues around selecting the key areas of the tool's consideration.(including development of Spaceshaper 9-14)
- People: The roles of project manager, facilitator, event support and event participants
- Typical event program comprising: Before the Event, the event and after the event
- Brief trialling of completing the Spaceshaper questionnaire and 9-14 materials on a nearby site and in the venue.
- Reflective discussion on the Spaceshaper process and its potential use across the different types of site managed by the attendees.

Session 3: P2P- Policy to Pavement

Policy to Pavement (P2P) is an initiative of One Eighty (SA), Clouston Landscape Architects (NSW & NT) and VisualVoice Wayfinding (VIC). The concept originated over 3 years ago when One Eighty partnered with Clouston on the day to day issues with developing sustainable, active and vibrant streetscapes to encourage incidental activity. The concept has now grown to include four critical aspects of establishing a clear Policy for healthy environments, Planning to identify hot spots within a community, Prioritising through proven auditing techniques and finally assessing the local environment (Pavement) to be conducive to activity and street life through wayfinding and design. This session will discuss each section of the process and invites feedback from practitioners on the ground.

Session 4: Using Health and Design Principles at Land Management Corporation

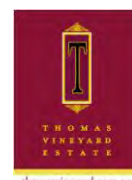
Kirsten Potoczky- Health Design and Social Planning Officer, Land Management Corporation

Now based at LMC Kirsten is involved in transferring lessons from this work to other LMC developments while continuing her involvement at Lightsvue. Kirsten will talk about the practical aspects of implementing the theory of Healthy by Design, and the easy gains and the principles that face challenges. Kirsten will also talk about implementing health design principles into the operating policy of Land Management Corporation through their Sustainability and Innovations Strategy and what this means with the trend to medium and higher density development.
