There have been changes in the way stormwater has been managed and viewed over recent years. The White Paper highlights the enormous potential for improvements in attitude toward stormwater and its management. DSE is currently reviewing planning regulations pertaining to sub divisions. The draft review will be put out for a period public comment. Melbourne Water has launched new WSUD guidelines, consolidating several years of recent experience in the areas of stormwater management and water quality improvement.
