- rain garden/biofiltration system design configurations
- media selection, sizing and plant selection
- design enhancements (SAZ, exfiltration, additives)
- testing performance
- observations of rain gardens/biofiltration systems in different soil types and hydrological conditions

Day 2 offers an opportunity to have your individual projects reviewed and discussed with leading professionals in the industry. Topics include:

- designing rain gardens for your situation
- sizing and design attributes
- construction
- Soil media and drainage layer

 - developing stormwater treatment using rain gardens
 - tackling retrofit or greenfield sites
 - overcoming technical challenges and site restraints.
