Greg will present an overview of his firm's work in the Kimberley and Pilbara, the result of his persistent commitment to engagement facilitating design outcomes with local community members in pursuit of understanding the concept of "connection to country".

UDLA's design philosophy hinges on the realisation of humankind's custodian relationship within the landscape and that a communities' capacity has a symbiotic relationship with the standard or richness of their spatial amenity.

Greg is principal of UDLA, a small urban design and landscape architecture practice. Much of UDLA's work focus's on urban infill and regional town centre developments within the north west WA, many of these are mid size pastoral and mining towns that include high indigenous populations.
