SPACESHAPER FACILITATION ACCREDITATION IN PERTH 7th–9th APRIL

PLA has resolved to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Commission on Architecture and the Built Environment (CABE) to introduce SPACESHAPER, the leading edge open space planning tool, to Australasia. We are holding the three day accreditation course in Perth from the 7th–9th April 2010. This is your opportunity to:

- Gain new skills;
- Be amongst the first SpaceShaper facilitators in Australia and New Zealand;
- Be part of a leading edge program to reinvigorate our public places.

WHY USE SPACESHAPER?

- It brings people with varying interests together to consider the space.
- It identifies the strengths and weaknesses of the space.
- It establishes what is most important to people.
- It measures how well the space meets everyone's needs.
- It stimulates new ideas for improvement.
- It is able to track changes in people's views on the space.

WHAT WILL THE TRAINING COVER

Over the three days, the SpaceShaper Enabler we are bringing to Perth from the UK will

- Bring you the background to SpaceShaper;
- Provide an overview of SpaceShaper in action;
- Introduce you to the tool;
- Run an experiential learning session involving a review of an actual space; and
- Familiarise you with the SpaceShaper software and planning process.

DAY ONE

Background to SpaceShaper and making connections to own work/projects. Participants will look at SpaceShaper and its unique advantages. Identifying the specifics that participants seek to ensure that SpaceShaper can meet your own objectives and be a key part of your consultative tool kit. The sessions will be interactive and iterative.

DAY TWO

SpaceShaper in practice. Participants will look at what it does and examine some case studies from the UK in a wide variety of contexts — urban parks, squares, streets, peri-urban parks. It will examine issues associated within a wide variety of environments and user groups. Eg – cultural issues, special needs.

Live SpaceShaper event. Participants will look at a real site near to the training venue with a wide variety of interest groups and see how SpaceShaper works in action, from the initiation to the data input and analysis.

DAY THREE

SpaceShaper software and planning—Participants will become familiar with the SpaceShaper software and understand and be comfortable with the process of inputting the data and generating reports, diagrams, bar charts etc. Developing strategies to manage a SpaceShaper event, including who to invite, timing, brush up on facilitation skills, managing arguments and discussion, SpaceShaper resourcing needs, and project management.

OUTCOMES

At the conclusion of the training program, participants will be accredited as SpaceShaper facilitators, have access to online support for the following twelve months and be part of the Australian SpaceShaper facilitators network. You will be able to log on to the system, gain a space access number and password and have the skills to run a SpaceShaper workshop in your community.

There will be the opportunity to work together with other facilitators to gain experience and share ideas, approaches and issues.

Participants will be automatically included in the SpaceShaper Enabler support network run through PLA. PLA membership will be a requirement of continued participation in the SpaceShaper network.

ACCREDITATION

Only accredited SpaceShaper facilitators can access the SpaceShaper software and utilise the tool.

RESOURCES

If you have access to a laptop you can bring, this would be useful. If you have a space in mind then you should bring along information including plans or photographs. (Note—this is not essential)

THE FACILITATOR

Michael Westley BA Hons DipLA DipHort CMLI is a Chartered Landscape Architect with 20 years of experience in landscape, urban & inclusive design and in teaching, research & publication.

His portfolio includes work in the private, public & voluntary sectors including appointments as an establishing Principal for a Groundwork Trust (South West), Program Manager for the Sensory Trust, an Inclusive Design Charity, and as a CABE Space Enabler & Advisor.
